







<p>Homefields Primary School Reading Vipers</p>	<p>KSI - These are the key reading skills for children to be able to read and comprehend a wide range of literary texts.</p>
	<p>Draw upon knowledge of vocab in the text to understand the text. Example questions What does the word.... mean? Find and copy a word which means....? What does the word or phrase tell you about.....? Which of the words best describes the character/setting/mood?</p>
	<p>Make inferences from the text. Example questions Why was..... feeling.....? Why did.....happen? Why did..... say.....? Can you explain why.....? What do you think the author intended when they said.....? How does..... make you feel?</p>
	<p>Predict what you think will happen based on the information that you have been given. Example questions Look at the book cover/blurb- what do you think this book will be about? What do you think will happen next? What makes you think this? How does the choice of character or setting affect what will happen next?</p>
	<p>Explain your preferences, thoughts and opinions about the text. Example questions Who is your favourite character? Why? Would you like to live in this setting? Why/why not? Is there anything you would change about this story? Do you like this text? What do you like about it?</p>
	<p>Identify and explain Example questions Who did.....? Where did.....? When did.....? Why did..... happen? How many.....? What happened to.....? What happened when.....?</p>
	<p>Sequence the key events in the story Example questions Can you remember these events 1-5 in the order they happened? What happened after.....? What was the first thing that happened in the story?</p>
