FSI	Children will be listening to a range of stories during story time and we will also look at a range of texts during our topics. We will visit the school library and encourage children to develop a love of books and reading! We will work with the children to help them recognise print in the environment. We will begin to retell stories through role play and small play and begin to think about how stories are structured. We will take part in Phase I Letters and Sounds, embedding the early phonic learning skills in all children. We will encourage the children to explore different ways of mark making using a variety of resources. We will help the children to learn and develop their pencil control and gain confidence in mark making.
