

Skills (threshold concepts)

Threshold concepts are the 'big ideas' that shape students' thinking within each subject. The same threshold concepts will be explored in every year group and students will gradually increase their understanding of them.

Knowledge

Concepts need knowledge to make sense. Contexts give students subject specific knowledge. We develop context through our knowledge topics.

The more knowledge students have, the better their understanding of the concepts becomes. Key knowledge is transferred into long-term memory and applied fluently.

Enrichment

We want our children to be motivated and engaged. We want our curriculum to be inspirational. We enrich our curriculum by;

- Creative Curriculum from Nursery to Year 6
- Bespoke Outdoor Learning curriculum/ Forest School and Eco Council
- Music Tuition of a tuned instrument for all children (mapped in Yr3/4)
